### Mode of action

**Xylanase:** Catalyzes the degradation of the linear polysaccharide, Xylan into xylanase which one of the significant components of the plant cell wall

 $\alpha$  – amylase: Enhances the digestibility of starch to improve energy balance and increase milk production

 $\beta$ -glucanase: Breaks down beta-glucans, a type of complex carbohydrate found in grains like barley and oats that can reduce nutrient digestibility

**Cellulase:** Enables the digestion of high-fiber plant material which cannot break down on their own

**Pectinase:** Works by breaking down pectin which lowers feed viscosity, improves nutrient absorption and liberates trapped nutrients

β- mannanase: Breaks down β-mannans in the feed, which improves nutrient digestibility, enhances feed efficiency, and supports overall health

Lipase: Breaks down fats, or triglycerides into smaller fatty acids for digestion and absorption

**Autolyzed Yeast:** Improves cattle health and performance by enhancing the immune system, improving rumen function and nutrient absorption and aiding digestion

- To increase body weight by improving FCR
- To enhance the quality & Quantity of milk
- To improve fiber digestibility in the diet significantly
